As per N.J.A.C. 6A: 16- 2.1, 2.2 and pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:40-4., the Fort Lee Board of Education advises parents of the importance of students obtaining a physical examination at least once during each of the developmental stages:

- Early childhood (kindergarten through grade 3)
- Pre-adolescence (grade 4 through 6)
- Adolescence (grade 7 through 12)

Medical examinations should be conducted by the student's own physician or advanced practice nurse, in the physician's office, where a thorough physical examination can be given and follow-up done as necessary. If your child does not have a healthcare provider, please check the selection below and return this form to the school nurse or teacher's office as soon as possible.

Please have your child's healthcare provider complete the FORM 02-D-02 Universal Child Health Form, including an attached copy of all immunizations, at the time of the examination. All parents / guardians must also complete the attached FORM 02-D-04 Medical History form and return it to school.

Please return the attached forms to the school nurse or teacher as soon as possible.
